Overview

This document highlights all the improvements and resolved issues in QW 6 License Server releases.

Improvements

- New installer – This version uses a more modern installer technology and will make new installations and upgrades a smoother experience for users including issues relating to uninstalling the product.
- This version improves labeling for the product to ensure names are clear and consistent across the entire experience. This includes renaming the QW License Server Tray to QW License Server. The components are named the following:
 - QW License Server – Main Application
 - QW License Admin – Administration Applications
 - QW6LicenseServer – Windows Service
- Improved Logging for License Server Queries have been added to show activity from clients that are querying the License server for current state. This works for both version 5 and version 6 clients.
- The option to Allow duplicate Connections was removed to simplify the administrative experience. This option is on by default and can no longer be disabled as it only creates more limitations for users and can create a scenario where a single user can consume all seats for a license.
- The option to log to a QW Application has been removed due to little usage and potential conflicts when installed with Quality Window on the same device.
- In previous versions of QW License Server, shared components were preventing customers from installing Quality Window on the same machine as QW License Server, this version removes this limitation allowing the device to have both products installed at the same time.

Fixed Issues

- An issue was resolved where when a user clicks on the add product dialog cancel button an error is generated.
- This version resolves an issue where if the QW License Server Admin console is open and a user attempts to open it again from the QW License Server application, an error is thrown.

- Return valid session license number on CONNECT for backward compatibility with QW5 clients

2023-05-09 | Build 6.00.254

- Fixed connection data file writing improper data format for records. This file is used to track and restore active connections when service is restarted.
- Server responses include more detailed error messages when appropriate. Client is responsible for displaying these messages accordingly.

2023-04-12 | Build 6.00.253

- To facilitate client workstation configuration, License Server Administrator now supports setting shared path and default data path for network resources. Client workstations will query license server for these values and automatically update.
- License Server supports auto discovery via UDP broadcast on port 5051 by default. Clients will send a broadcast packet on the network and License Server will respond with the listening address and port.
- Improved error trapping and sending error messages to the client workstation when they occur.
